Jenepher motioned to approve the payroll, John seconded, all in favor.

Managers' Report

Old Business

- Ethics Training James reminded everyone of the required ethics training. He will put together a session in the office with a few computers to make it more accessible for Trustees that have not taken the training.
- Line of Credit The Community Bank turned down our request for a line of credit. They
 suggested we come back after we pay down some of our debt.
- Budget Review James presented an early draft. He has others that he is still working on. The new FY26 Budget will be presented in January.

New Business

Write Offs – There were two customer write-offs totaling \$1034.98. There was a brief discussion about deposits and the ability to bill property owners for any of their tenants' debts when the tenant moves away without paying their total debt. The board agreed to have the office work with the property owners. A motion was made by John to approve the recommendation for the write-offs, Jenepher seconded, all in favor.

Regulator Control Panels – We have three 20-year-old regulator control panels. One is not working and will need to be replaced. The cost for Green Mountain Power to replace them would be \$2,700 for each unit plus installation. James let the board know we could replace all three with savings in labor costs, but we may not have the funds to do so. The other two are still working, but it is recommended to be replaced soon. The board left it to the General Manager to decide how to move forward.
